Disarming the System or Canceling an Accidental	
Alarm:	Press 1+Code
Arm to Stay (Level 2):	Press 2+Code
Arm to Away (Level 3)	Press 3+Code

Send a Medical Alarm:	time.

To arm your system silently:	Away

<u>Auto stay arming:</u> Your system will not arm to Level 3: Away if it does not recognize you have left the home. If the system does not see an Entry/Exit door open during the arming time down it will set the arming level back to Level 2: Stay.

Zone Bypassing: If the system shows an open zone it will protest the arming. The keypad will beep and read protest, to arm the system with the zone open press the "#" key labeled bypass. The system will arm, but the open zone will not be armed.

<u>Dialer Abort:</u> In order for your system to be SIA compliant it has a feature called Dialer Abort. This means you have a short grace period after the alarm goes off to input your code before the system reports an alarm.
